## McDonnell maintains large lead

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Public Policy Polling's final survey of the 2009 race for Governor in Virginia finds Bob McDonnell leading Creigh Deeds 56-42.

The same factors that allowed McDonnell to lead handily for most of the general election have held true to the end. He has a 63-33 advantage with independents and is winning 94% of the Republican vote while Deeds gets just 87% of the Democratic vote.

64% of poll respondents believe that McDonnell will win Tuesday's election to just 24% who think Deeds will prevail. Only 34% of Virginians think Deeds has made a strong case for why he should be Governor while 63% believe McDonnell has succeeded on that front.

As the election concludes 55% of voters in the state have a favorable opinion of McDonnell to 35% negative. A plurality of Virginians see Deeds unfavorably- 45% to 39% with a positive view of him.

It appears McDonnell will bring some folks along with him. Bill Bolling leads Jody Wagner 54-41 and Ken Cuccinelli has a 55-39 advantage over Steve Shannon. Additionally 48% of voters say they will choose a Republican for the House of Delegates to 39% planning to vote Democratic.

"The streak of good elections for Democrats in Virginia ends tomorrow," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Republicans are going to sweep the statewide races and the only real suspense is by how much."

PPP surveyed 1,457 likely Virginia voters from October 30<sup>th</sup> to November 1st. The survey's margin of error is +/-2.6%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
