Florida voters support a path to citizenship

Raleigh, N.C. – This most recent poll finds that Florida voters do not clearly support one political party over the other. While they like Republican Marco Rubio more than Democrat Bill Nelson, they side with Democrats on issues concerning immigration, civil unions, and gun laws.

Contrasting with President Obama's approval rating of 48%, Florida voters are not as impressed with their Democratic Senator, Bill Nelson, who is raking in a 38% approval and 40% disapproval rating. Republican Senator Marco Rubio fares a little better than his fellow colleague with an approval of 44% and a disapproval of 43%.

Diverging from his party on this particular issue, Marco Rubio scores a higher approval of his stance on immigration (31%) than the former Republican Governor of Florida, Jeb Bush, who is scraping in a mere 21% approval on this issue. Interestingly, even though these politicians have been said to be vocal about their immigration views, 42% of Florida voters are unsure of Rubio's stance while 57% are unsure of Bush's stance.

Overall, 53% of Floridians support legislation that would allow for a legal way for illegal immigrants in American to become U.S. citizens while 31% oppose it.

When asked about their views on legal rights for same sex couples, 38% of Florida voters think gay couples should be allowed to legally marry, 37% think gay couples should be allowed to form civil unions but not marry, only 23% think there should be no legal recognition of a gay couple's relationship and 2% were unsure.

More specific to Florida, 23% of voters support the domestic partnership bill in the Florida legislature while 17% oppose it (60% of the voters were unsure of the legislation).

"Florida voters support moving forward on the issues of immigration and gay rights," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "There's pretty strong support for a path to citizenship and for civil unions."

PPP surveyed 500 Florida voters from March 15th to 18th. The margin of error is +/-4.4%. This poll was not paid for or authorized by any campaign or political organization. PPP surveys are conducted through automated telephone interviews.
