Ryan helps Romney to small lead in Wisconsin

Raleigh, N.C. – The selection of Paul Ryan as his running mate has vaulted Mitt Romney into a small lead in Wisconsin, PPP's newest poll of the state finds. He's at 48% to 47% for Barack Obama. 50% of the state disapproves of Obama's job performance, an increase from 48% in a poll conducted in July.

Those surveyed in Wisconsin also indicate that the percentage in favor of Paul Ryan has increased, now at 49%. The state appears to approve Mitt Romney's choice for his Vice President running mate, Paul Ryan. When asked, 51% of those polled stated that if they were allowed to vote directly for Vice President, they would chose Paul Ryan.

Wisconsin's approval increase of Republican candidates could be in response to Paul Ryan's recent proposal to change Medicare. Ryan's plan includes providing a predetermined yearly amount of money to Medicare recipients to purchase coverage from outside providers, as well as a gradual increase in the age of eligibility from 65 to 67. Ryan's proposal comes with strong approval from Republicans, who have increased in their support of Romney over the last six weeks.

40% of those polled in Wisconsin support Paul Ryan's proposal for reforming Medicare. In addition, when polled in July, 44% of Wisconsin disagreed with the Supreme Court's ruling on the health care reform bill. Opinions on healthcare seem to be a determining factor for approval of Presidential and Vice Presidential candidates in the state.

Earlier this campaign season, Obama was likely to win in the Presidential race in Wisconsin. However, his competition is quickly gaining support in the state.

"Wisconsin really is starting to look like a toss up in the Presidential race," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "The big question is whether this is just a bounce from Paul Ryan's selection as running mate, or if the increased Republican competitiveness will prove to be lasting."

PPP will release new numbers on the Senate race in Wisconsin tomorrow.

PPP surveyed 1,308 likely Wisconsin voters from August 16th to 19th. The margin of error for the survey is +/-2.7%. This poll was not paid for or authorized by any campaign or political organization. PPP surveys are conducted through automated telephone interviews.
