N.C. Gun Owners Concerned for 2nd Amendment Right

Raleigh, N.C. – Survey data from Public Policy Polling finds that 51% of gun owners in North Carolina are concerned that President Barack Obama's administration will push for legislation making it more difficult for civilians to own guns.

Among these gun owners, 68% of Republicans and 53% of independent voters reported worrying that Obama will diminish their right to bear arms. Among North Carolinians who voted for Senator John McCain or a third-party candidate, 70% and 56%, respectively, are concerned about this.

However, 78% of all respondents think gun control laws should be at least moderately strict, if not more so.

Of those respondents who voted for Obama in the 2008 presidential election, 57% believe gun control laws should be very strict, whereas only 20% of McCain supporters wanted very strict legislation.

"North Carolinians who voted for McCain last November tend to think the government should exercise moderate control over gun ownership," said Katherine Rumbaugh, a spring fellow with PPP. "Voters who cast their ballots for a third-party candidate were the most likely to think gun control legislation should be minimally strict."

Independent or unaffiliated voters were also most likely to rank issues involving gun ownership as very important, at 59%.


Significantly more women than men think gun control laws should be very strict, a 47/30 difference. By race, more African Americans than white think these laws should be very strict by a ratio of nearly 2:1.

PPP surveyed 1105 North Carolina voters from February 6^{th} to 8^{th} . The survey's margin of error is $\pm 2.95\%$. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
