## Romney has small lead in early GOP polling

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Mitt Romney is picking up where he left off in 2012.

After announcing his intent to explore a third presidential run in as many election cycles, Romney has once again found himself at the front of the Republican presidential ticket. The former Massachusetts governor leads a still nebulous GOP field with 21% support, and he tracks as the most popular potential candidate at 62% favorability.

Former Florida Gov. Jeb Bush places second with 17% support among national Republican primary voters. Bush and Romney, pegged as two of the more moderate GOP hopefuls, emerge as front-runners among middle-of-the-road voters. Bush leads Romney with moderate Republicans 28/22, while Romney leads with somewhat conservative Republicans 27/18. The two are separated by just one point—Bush leads 26/25—among voters aged 18 to 45.

Chris Christie, who at one point was considered the champion of the moderate GOP wing, is exceedingly unpopular. The New Jersey governor's favorability rating has dropped to 35%, down six points from PPP's last nationwide poll of GOP primary voters in March. Christie, who was tied for third last spring and once led Hillary Clinton in a head-to-head in December of 2013, now finishes in seventh place with 7% support.

On the Democratic side, Clinton continues to dominate the field. She holds a 45-point lead among potential candidates, though that is down from the 55-point spread she posted in March. Nevertheless, she is by far the most popular and viable candidate for Democrats, as evidenced by her near unanimous 79% favorability rating and 92% name recognition. Elizabeth Warren, whom ultra-progressives have aggressively lobbied as a more liberal alternative to Clinton, has inched up to double digits at 10% support.

"The big picture on the Presidential primaries has remained pretty constant," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Hillary Clinton is the overwhelming favorite for the Democrats and the Republican side is a free for all."

PPP surveyed 400 Republican primary voters and 386 Democratic primary voters from January 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>. The margin of error is +/- 4.9% for the Republican survey and +/- 5.0% for the Democratic survey. 80% of interviews for the poll were conducted over the phone with 20% interviewed over the internet to reach respondents who don't have landline telephones.
