GOP Field, Minus Trump, Trumps Clinton in Kentucky

Raleigh, N.C. – PPP's recent poll among Kentucky voters finds that Hilary Clinton leads Donald Trump 45/42. Otherwise, Clinton trails all other GOP Presidential hopefuls. Mike Huckabee and Rand Paul each lead Clinton by ten points at 49/39 and 50/40 respectively. Other GOP candidates that lead Clinton include Ben Carson at 49/40, Jeb Bush at 48/40, Ted Cruz at 48/42, and Carly Fiorina at 45/40. Scott Walker and Marco Rubio both best Clinton 46/41. These gaps between Clinton and the field have widened since August of 2014 when she trailed Bush 48/43, lagged behind Huckabee 47/44, and even led Cruz 46/41.

Paul leads in his home state among Republican primary voters, although with a pretty underwhelming share of the vote. 19% would most like to see Paul as the GOP candidate for President in 2016. Jeb Bush is second at 13% followed by Trump with 12%, Walker with 12%, Rubio and Huckabee with 10% each, and Ben Carson at 7%. Cruz and Fiorina round out the group at 4%.

18-45 year old Republican voters support Paul in the highest numbers with 30% hoping to see him as the Republican presidential nominee. Trump has the next highest level of support among the same group with 14% and Bush is a close third place with 13%.

"Rand Paul's lack of dominance of the Republican field in his own state may not bode well for his prospects in other places," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "There doesn't seem to be very broad enthusiasm for his candidacy even among the voters who know him best."

On the Democratic side Clinton maintains sizable leads over the primary field with 56% of Democrats selecting her as their first choice for President. Bernie Sanders is a distant second at 12%, Jim Webb is at 7%, Lincoln Chafee is at 5%, and Martin O'Malley is at 3%. Democratic voters view Clinton and Sanders favorably at 60/33 and 27/24 respectively.

Public Policy Polling surveyed 1,108 registered voters, including 610 Democratic primary voters and 413 Republican primary voters, from June 18^{th} -21st. The margin of error is +/-2.9% for the overall survey, +/-4.0% for the Democrats, and +/-4.8% for the Republicans. 80% of participants responded via the phone, while 20% of respondents who did not have landlines conducted the survey over the internet.
