Dems like Ginsburg, GOP likes Thomas, and Neither Like SCOTUS

Raleigh, N.C. – As part of a larger national poll, PPP surveyed registered voters on their opinions of the Supreme Court of the United States (SCOTUS). When asked which of the nine Supreme Court justices they disliked the most 28% of Democrats chose Clarence Thomas while 25% of Republicans chose Ruth Bader Ginsburg. These numbers reversed when each party claimed their favorite justice with 31% of Democrats favoring Ginsburg and 21% of Republicans selecting Thomas.

Overall, voters have an unfavorable opinion of SCOTUS 35/41 with Republicans viewing it more unfavorably at 30/48 than the 37/39 among Democrats. Voters are split on the ideological bias of SCOTUS with 33% claiming it is too liberal, 27% saying it is too conservative, and 29% taking the position that the SCOTUS is just right.

Despite being viewed unfavorably, most individual justices are viewed more favorably than not. Anthony Kennedy is viewed favorably 28/18, Ruth Bader Ginsburg at 36/29, Stephen Breyer at 20/17, Samuel Alito at 24/21, Sonia Sotomayor at 38/30, and Elena Kagan at 26/24. Those viewed more unfavorably are John Roberts at 18/27 and Antonin Scalia at 27/29. Clarence Thomas remains even at 32/32.

Three candidates were more favorable than unfavorable among Hispanic, White, and African-American voters. Kennedy was viewed favorably 32/17 among Hispanic voters, 26/18 among White voters, and 30/15 among African-American voters. Ginsberg was seen favorably 35/30, 35/32, and 45/10 among Hispanic, White, and African-American voters, respectively. Sotomayor garnered favorability numbers at 51/29, 35/32, and 57/12 among those same groups.

"Ruth Bader Ginsburg and Clarence Thomas are the Supreme Court member Americans have the strongest feelings about," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Ginsburg is the most popular overall despite being the most unpopular with Republicans, and Thomas is the least popular overall despite being the most popular with Republicans."

Public Policy Polling surveyed 1,129 voters nationally between June 11th and 14th. The margin of error for the overall survey is +/-2.9%. 80% of participants responded via the phone, while 20% of respondents who did not have landlines conducted the survey over the internet.
