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#### **Unannounced Kasich Leads GOP Field on Home Turf**

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Ohio Republican Governor John Kasich has a strong showing among Republicans in his home state in a recent Public Policy Polling survey, leading the hotly contested primary with 19% of the vote. Scott Walker and Ben Carson follow at 13% each, Jeb Bush and Marco Rubio have 12%, Rand Paul has 9%, and Mike Huckabee, Ted Cruz, and Chris Christie round out the field with 6%, 5%, and 4% respectively.

"Republicans in John Kasich's home state support him for President," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "That's more than a lot of the GOP hopefuls can say in their home states."

Kasich has yet to officially announce his candidacy, yet he leads Hillary Clinton 47/40 in the state. This is a testament to Kasich's popularity in the state- he has a 49/35 approval, a number that is 72/11 among Republicans.

On the Democratic side Clinton still dominates the field with 61% of the primary vote, followed by Bernie Sanders at 13%, Michael Bloomberg at 7%, Lincoln Chafee and Martin O'Malley at 2%, and Jim Webb at 1%. 13% of Democratic voters are still undecided.

Despite trailing Kasich and Rand Paul (44/41), Clinton retains her head-to-head lead against other Republican candidates, although they are all by narrow margins. Clinton leads Bush 45/43, Carson 44/43, Christie 44/41, Cruz 44/43, Huckabee 45/42, and Walker 44/43. She is tied with Rubio at 44.

Kasich enjoys home state favor in his potential run for the White House, a rarity in most cases. For example, Clinton leads Bush 47/44 and Rubio 48/46 in Florida. Wisconsin voters chose Clinton 52/43 over Walker this March. These positive numbers may not hold outside the battleground state of Ohio, but good numbers in the state could give Kasich the momentum he needs for an announcement later this June.

Public Policy Polling surveyed 859 Ohio voters, including 411 Republican primary voters and 360 Democratic primary voters, between June  $4^{th}$  and 7th. The margin of error for the overall survey is +/-3.3%, for the Republicans it's +/-4.8%, and for the Democrats it's +/-5.2%. 80% of participants responded via the phone, while 20% of respondents who did not have landlines conducted the survey over the internet.
