Bush, Walker virtually tied in early South Carolina primary preview

Raleigh, N.C. – Jeb Bush and Scott Walker are neck-and-neck for the top spot in South Carolina's 2016 Republican primary race, PPP's latest statewide poll shows.

Bush edges out Walker by one point among South Carolina GOP primary voters, 19/18. The poll is PPP's first without Mitt Romney in the field, and, consequently, the first to show Bush in front. Behind Bush and Walker are Ben Carson and South Carolina Sen. Lindsey Graham tied in third at 13% support; Mike Huckabee in fifth with 12%; and Chris Christie, Rand Paul, Ted Cruz, and Rick Perry are all in single digits.

The source of Bush's lead can be traced to moderate voters, of whom 36% support the former Florida governor. Walker, who is also cast as a more moderate choice, performs surprisingly well with Tea Party voters with 32% support. National Tea Party leader Ted Cruz gets just 8% of the South Carolina Tea Party vote. South Carolina remains a hotbed of conservative politics. Just 34% of South Carolina Republicans believe in evolution, and even fewer—31%—believe that global warming exists. Despite news of a nationwide measles outbreak, 29% of GOP voters believe parents should be able to decide whether their children receive vaccinations or not.

"Last week a lot of attention was paid to Scott Walker's hesitance to say he believed in evolution and these numbers show why," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Republican voters in key places like South Carolina continue to be extremely conservative on issues like that and global warming."

Republicans and Democrats alike do not want to see home state Sen. Graham make a presidential run in 2016. Substantial majorities of general voters (66%) and Republican primary voters (61%) want Graham to stay out of the race. Unsurprisingly, Republicans perform well in hypothetical general election matchups. Every potential Republican candidate polled wins his matchup with Democratic frontrunner Hillary Clinton, though none win by more than eight points.

PPP surveyed 868 registered South Carolina voters, including 525 Republican primary voters and 252 Democratic primary voters, from February 12^{th} to 15^{th} . The margin of error for the overall survey is \pm -3.3%, it's \pm -4.3% for the GOP sample, and it's \pm -6.2% for the Democratic sample. 80% of interviews for the poll were conducted over the phone with 20% interviewed over the internet to reach respondents who don't have landline telephones.
