Johnson vulnerable in 2016 Senate race; tough Feingold rematch looms

Raleigh, N.C. – First-term Republican Senator Ron Johnson is on the rocks with Wisconsin voters ahead of his first re-election campaign in 2016.

Johnson, who rode the Republican tidal wave of 2010 to victory over longtime incumbent Democrat Russ Feingold, comes in at just 32% approval, making him one of the least popular senators in the country.

Feingold, meanwhile, is the most popular Wisconsin politician included in this poll with 46/35 favorability. He holds a healthy nine-point lead over Johnson in a hypothetical rematch of their 2010 race, 50/41. Both Wisconsin Democrats and Independents are nostalgic for Feingold's return to Washington, supporting his bid over Johnson 86/4 and 52/38, respectively. Feingold is so popular with Democrats that the last time PPP polled in the state in April 2014, the former three-term senator placed second only to Hillary Clinton in a hypothetical Democratic presidential primary race.

Johnson does better against Democrats not named Russ Feingold, however. Just one other Democrat—former gubernatorial candidate Mary Burke—manages to put up a proper challenge to the Tea Party senator, topping him by one point, 46/45. Johnson defeats the other three Democrats polled—U.S. Reps. Ron Kind, Gwen Moore, and Mark Pocan—by at least six points, though all have name recognition ratings of 50% or lower.

"Russ Feingold starts out looking like a favorite if he tries to reclaim his old seat from Ron Johnson," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Johnson hasn't gained much footing with Wisconsin voters, and Feingold has remained pretty popular even after losing in 2010."

Congressman Paul Ryan is the second most popular politician polled in the state at a +8 net favorability rating (46/38 overall), up seven points from April 2014.

Voters are largely unfazed by the legalization of gay marriage in the state late last year. 70% say it has had no impact on their lives, including 58% of very conservative voters.

PPP surveyed 1,071 registered Wisconsin voters from March 6^{th} to 8^{th} . The margin of error for the survey is \pm -3.0%. 80% of interviews for the poll were conducted over the phone with 20% interviewed over the internet to reach respondents who don't have landline telephones.
