## **Burr approval weak, still leads**

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Richard Burr continues to have a weak approval rating for an incumbent Senator, but he’s seen some improvement in the numbers he posts against a generic Democratic candidate over the last month.

36% of North Carolinians express approval this month for the job Burr’s doing while 33% disapprove. He’s got 63% of Republicans, 36% of independents, and 16% of Democrats behind him. At 31% there are still an unusually large number of voters with no opinion about him one way or the other.

Despite his tepid approval Burr this month leads a generic Democratic opponent 45-36, the best performance he’s posted since October. Given the lack of shift in Burr’s own numbers this improvement is likely due to the worsening national political climate for Democrats. Burr has a 46-25 lead among independents.

Tested against his actual Democratic opponents, Burr leads Elaine Marshall 44-37, Cal Cunningham 45-36, and Kenneth Lewis 46-34. None of his challengers are particularly well known. Marshall has 30% name recognition, Lewis is at 17%, and 15% of voters have an opinion about Cunningham.

“Richard Burr’s fate is tied up in something larger than Richard Burr,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. “If this continues to be a huge Republican year he’s going to get reelected. But he remains a weak incumbent and should things get better for Democrats this will be a spirited race.”

PPP will release new numbers on Barack Obama tomorrow.

PPP surveyed 678 North Carolina voters from January 15<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>. The survey’s margin of error is +/-3.8%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
