## **Voters lack knowledge about candidates**

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Few of the people planning to vote in next week’s primary for the Senate in North Carolina can identify even the most basic facts about the leading candidates in the race.

Only 47% know that Elaine Marshall is the Secretary of State, just 30% are aware that Cal Cunningham served in Iraq, and 15% can name Kenneth Lewis as the candidate who’s been endorsed by many major black leaders in the state.

The numbers on Cunningham are a clear indicator of the power of television ads. In the Triangle and Triad where he’d already been up on the air when the poll was conducted 47% and 40% respectively of voters were able to identify his Iraq service. In Charlotte and the mountains, where he was not yet on tv, only 15% and 11% could.

Voters in the Triangle are more knowledgeable about the candidates across the board. While only 15% statewide know about Lewis’ endorsements, 27% there do. While just 47% overall know Marshall’s current office, 64% in that region do.

The particularly troublesome crosstab for Lewis is that there are more black voters who think that Marshall has been endorsed by Mel Watt, Harvey Gantt, and Eva Clayton than there are who can correctly name Lewis as the recipient of these endorsements.

“We’ve known for a long time that a lot of voters were undecided in this race and now we have a better idea of why,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. “The fact that they don’t know the most elementary of facts about the candidates is a clear indication that most voters are operating on very little information.”

PPP surveyed 458 likely Democratic primary voters from April 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>. The margin of error for the survey is +/-4.6%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
