Majority of North Carolinians believe the U.S. should have “stayed out” of Iraq

Raleigh, N.C. – In a new poll conducted by Public Policy Polling 51% of North Carolinians think the United States should have stayed out of Iraq compared to 41% who think the U.S. did the right thing.

In regard to the number of troops currently on the ground in Iraq, a plurality of respondents at 31% felt that U.S. troops should be withdrawn immediately. Only 12% felt that troop levels should be increased.

The survey also measured attitudes toward the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. 43% of North Carolinians expressed a belief in a two-state solution, while 61% believe the U.S. should support the state of Israel at all costs.

John D. Willingham, summer fellow at PPP, noted that “this poll indicates that while a majority of North Carolina voters are frustrated with the U.S. involvement in Iraq, there is some division among respondents over the number of U.S. boots on the ground. Obviously, success has become difficult to judge in this particular conflict, especially considering the difficult nature of a counterinsurgency campaign.”

On a side note, this survey measured religious attitudes among North Carolinians. 66% of respondents identified themselves as “born again” Christians and 74% said they would remain faithful to their religious beliefs if forced to choose between keeping their job and adhering to their beliefs. 55% of respondents believe that the existence of the state of Israel is part of a biblical prophecy.

PPP surveyed 614 likely voters on July 10 and 11. The survey’s margin of error is +/- 3.95%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
