Majority of Florida voters support Medicaid expansion

Raleigh, N.C. – Floridians want Governor Rick Scott to deliver Medicaid expansion to the Sunshine State.

For a second straight poll, PPP has found that Florida voters support federally funded Medicaid expansion 2-to-1. Floridians back the effort 58/26, about the same as the 61/27 spread recorded in September 2014, the last time PPP polled Florida voters on the Medicaid issue. Strong majorities of Independents (57/29) and young voters (72/12) endorse accepting federal dollars to extend health insurance to the poorest Floridians.

Gov. Scott has pledged his support for Medicaid expansion but has yet to deliver during his tenure in Tallahassee. His net approval rating stands at -4 (42/46) despite winning reelection in November. Democratic Senator Bill Nelson enjoys a favorable +12 net approval rating (43/31). Scott has recently made noises about a potential Senate run in 2018 when he leaves office. He would start out trailing Nelson 47/43 in a hypothetical contest.

But when it comes to popularity in Florida, neither Scott nor Nelson can hold a candle to Tim Tebow. The two-time BCS National Champion carries a mammoth +40 net favorability rating (53/13), including a 73/1 spread with very conservatives. Tebow's legend has lost a little bit of its luster after his humbling stint in the NFL—Tebow has slipped 27 points in net favorability since PPP's last reading in January 2012.

Tebow's alma mater Florida edges out Florida State as the most popular college program in the state, 23/22. Florida fans are taking a wait-and-see approach with new head coach Jim McElwain—66% have not yet formed an opinion on the former Colorado State coach—while Jimbo Fisher enjoys a 55/6 approval rating with Seminole fans.

Consistent with previous polls, Floridians' favorite MLB teams do not play in their state. The Atlanta Braves and the New York Yankees are the two most popular baseball teams in Florida at 17% and 14% support, respectively, followed by the Miami Marlins at 12% and the Tampa Bay Rays at 11%.

PPP surveyed 923 registered Florida voters from March 19^{th} to 22^{nd} . The margin of error for the survey is +/- 3.2%. 80% of interviews for the poll were conducted over the phone with 20% interviewed over the internet to reach respondents who don't have landline telephones.
