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## Maine Governor's Race Wide Open

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Maine voters aren't too familiar with any of the leading candidates for Governor next year, and that leaves the race to replace John Baldacci wide open.

30% of voters say that generally speaking they plan to vote Democratic for Governor next year with 26% intending to vote Republican and 18% saying their preference would be an independent candidate. Maine has been more fertile ground for candidates outside the major two parties than most states, and in a political climate where voters are pretty unhappy with both the Democrats and the Republicans there could be an opening.

Voters in the state are mostly unfamiliar with even some of the better known candidates on both the Democratic and Republican sides. 66% have no opinion about Senate President Libby Mitchell and 75% are ambivalent toward former Attorney General Steve Rowe. 69% are neutral toward repeat candidate Peter Mills and 75% say the same about Les Otten.

Some preliminary head to head contests show an opportunity for Republicans to be successful next year, but also lots of undecided voters. Mills lead Mitchell 34-31 and Rowe 33-25. In both match ups a plurality of the electorate is still undecided. The Democrats each lead Otten- Mitchell by a 34-26 margin and Rowe by a 28-26 spread but again a very significant proportion of the electorate hasn't given it much thought.

"The only thing that's certain about next year's Gubernatorial race is that everything is uncertain," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "There really are no clear favorites and that means just about anything, including the election of an independent or third party candidate, is possible."

PPP surveyed 1,130 likely voters from October 16<sup>th</sup> to 19th. The survey's margin of error is +/-2.9%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
