Dead Heat in Missouri Senate Race

Raleigh, N.C. – When Public Policy Polling first looked at the open Senate seat in Missouri in January Robin Carnahan led Roy Blunt 45-44. Fast forward ten months and the race has hardly changed at all, with Carnahan now up 43-42.

This contest exemplifies the difficulties Democrats are having nationally right now. Carnahan is a good deal better liked than Blunt. 40% of voters in the state have a favorable opinion of her with only 36% viewing her negatively compared to 30% with a positive perception of Blunt and 38% seeing him unfavorably. Despite that superior popularity she leads by only a point, likely because 58% of voters in the state have an unfavorable opinion of the Democrats in Congress.

Voters are already looking at this contest in a rigidly partisan manner. 83% of Democrats say that they'll support Carnahan and 82% of Republicans plan to vote for Blunt. The Republican has a 44-32 lead with independent voters, continuing a trend that exhibited itself in New Jersey and Virginia.

“If Robin Carnahan had faced off against Roy Blunt in any election year between 1996 and 2008 she would likely have won given her superior popularity,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. “But 2010 has the potential to be an extremely good year for Republicans, and that’s made this race highly competitive.”

Republican State Senator Chuck Purgason is also running. He trails Blunt 53-16 in the primary and has a 42-35 gap against Carnahan in a potential general election contest that’s not likely to occur.

PPP will release approval numbers tomorrow on the state’s top elected officials.

PPP surveyed 763 Missouri voters from November 13th to 15th. The survey’s margin of error is +/-3.6%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
