### **With Romney out, Bush, Carson, Walker tied in NC**

**Raleigh, N.C.** – Mitt Romney’s exit from the 2016 race leaves Jeb Bush, Ben Carson, and Scott Walker tied at the top of the Republican field in North Carolina.

Excluding Romney, who announced his decision to stay out of the race Friday while the survey was being conducted, Bush, Carson, and Walker are knotted at 14% in a foggy field of potential candidates. Mike Huckabee is close behind with 13% support.

The biggest story is Walker. This marks the first time PPP has found the Wisconsin governor in the lead pack in a 2016 poll. Despite his success, Walker is relatively unknown in North Carolina—49% of the general population and 41% of Republicans have no opinion of him. He performs well with both very conservative and somewhat conservative voters, however, coming in second and third, respectively. Ben Carson leads with both groups.

Bush, who leads with moderate Republicans, is falling out of favor with the party as a whole. His favorability rating has dropped 16 points among GOP voters since December.

The three top GOP candidates perform almost identically well in matchups with Democratic favorite Hillary Clinton. Bush and Carson tie with Clinton, while Walker trails just two points.

Among North Carolina Democrats, Clinton still reigns supreme. Her lead is at a steady 36 points over second place finisher Joe Biden. Elizabeth Warren’s share of the vote has risen five points since December to 12%.

“Scott Walker hit double digits in our national polling for the first time last week, then led the Iowa Poll, and is now tied for the lead in North Carolina,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. “It’s becoming pretty clear that he’s the first Republican Presidential hopeful to catch fire in 2015.”

PPP surveyed 845 registered North Carolina voters, including 400 Republican primary voters and 385 Democratic primary voters from January 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup>. The margin of error for the survey is +/- 3.4%, +/- 4.9 for the GOP sample, and +/- 5.0 for the Democratic portion. 80% of interviews for the poll were conducted over the phone with 20% interviewed over the internet to reach respondents who don’t have landline telephones.
