Playoff win earns Rivera another chance with Panthers fans

Raleigh, N.C. – The adage “winning takes care of everything” is proving true for Carolina Panthers head coach Ron Rivera, whom PPP’s latest North Carolina poll finds is no longer on the hot seat with fans after his second division title in as many years.

Net support for Rivera’s return next season has catapulted to +57, up 45 points from early December, when the Panthers were in the midst of a six-game losing streak and seemingly out of playoff contention. Panthers fans, who comprise 40% of the North Carolina electorate, give Rivera a +55 net approval rating, up 50 points from December. Democrats and Republicans are equally willing to forgive the fact that Rivera has posted just one winning season since he arrived four years ago, supporting his return 70/10 and 67/11, respectively.

Two North Carolina members of Congress have made national headlines recently—Thom Tillis with his remarks that restaurant employees should not be required to wash their hands, and Renee Ellmers with her votes against House Republicans’ measures on abortion and immigration. This survey was conducted before Tillis made his remarks, but it was able to capture conservatives’ dissatisfaction with Ellmers. Her standing among right-wing North Carolinians has taken such a hit that she is now viewed as unfavorably with very conservative voters (18/34) as she is with very liberal ones (19/36).

The North Carolina General Assembly, which convenes this week, is also on bad terms with voters at 23/51 approval. Support for Democrats and Republicans in the state legislature is split—voters say they would vote for a Republican candidate over a Democratic candidate in their own district 45/43.

“The legislature continues to be extremely unpopular as it begins its new session,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling.

A majority (60%) of North Carolinians don’t have an opinion on the controversial ouster of UNC President Tom Ross. Conservative financier Art Pope, who is rumored to be angling for Ross’s job, is not a popular choice for his replacement, with just 12% support.

PPP surveyed 845 registered North Carolina voters from January 29th to 31st. The margin of error for the survey is +/- 3.4%. 80% of interviews for the poll were conducted over the phone with 20% interviewed over the internet to reach respondents who don’t have landline telephones.
