Burr leads Dems, but under 50%

Raleigh, N.C. – Republican Senator Richard Burr currently holds an advantage against most potential Democratic challengers in the North Carolina Senate election next year, Public Policy Polling finds.

Voters said that they would choose Burr in the 2010 U.S. Senate election over a number of notable Democrats, including Elizabeth Edwards, Lieutenant Governor Walter Dalton, state Senator Dan Blue, former state Treasurer Richard Moore, Congressmen Bob Etheridge and Heath Shuler, and former state Senator Cal Cunningham.

The name Democrat who comes closest to Burr is Edwards, wife of former Presidential hopeful John Edwards, and the only one of the group that does not have previous electoral experience. 35% of North Carolina voters said they would select Edwards in 2010, while 46% said they would choose Burr.

Although Burr holds a sizeable advantage over his potential Democratic opponents, he never cracks the 50% mark considered safe for an incumbent in any of the contests.

PPP also asked about Cal Cunningham, providing a brief biographical statement of him, and he polled the closest to Burr of the Democrats, trailing 42-34. That's a good reminder that having a good story to tell can be more important than initial name recognition, as was shown by Kay Hagan's victory last fall.

"This race is shaping up very similarly to 2008," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Although it's taking Democrats a while to get a candidate, Burr's standing is still tenuous, and getting someone with a lot of name recognition isn't necessarily that important to winning next year."

PPP surveyed 798 North Carolina voters from May 19th to 21st. The survey's margin of error is +/-3.5%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
