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## **Christie lead widens**

**Raleigh, N.C.** – After his lead was reduced to a single point in a Public Policy Polling survey two weeks ago, Chris Christie has now widened his advantage to four.

Christie's at 42% in the newest poll to 38% for Jon Corzine and 13% for Chris Daggett.

Earlier in the race it had appeared that Daggett was hurting Christie more, but now supporters of the independent candidate say by a 44-32 margin that their second choice would be Corzine. 43% of voters planning to support him are Democrats while only 9% are Republicans.

The shift in where Daggett's support is coming from is likely a result of the negative ads Chris Christie's campaign has run against him. Where his favorability rating was a positive 30/24 two weeks ago it's now a negative 31/36, and the climb in people rating him unfavorably has come largely among Republicans.

Corzine has some room to grow in the final week. For instance he's getting just 67% of the black vote and 53% of the Hispanic vote, both less than Democrats usually get and places where last second visits from Barack Obama could help him improve his standing.

60% of voters see Corzine unfavorably to 33% positively. For Christie it's a nearly even split with 45% holding a favorable opinion of him to 44% negative.

"This race is going right down to the wire," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "The Daggett voters seem to be pretty volatile so if they go back to the Corzine camp he'll have a good shot of pulling it out. The campaign that does the better job of turning out its voters will win."

PPP surveyed 630 likely New Jersey voters from October 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26th. The survey's margin of error is +/-3.9%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
