## Haley Popular; Clinton Trails GOP Field in South Carolina

Raleigh, N.C. – -PPP's newest South Carolina poll finds that Nikki Haley has become one of the most popular Governors in the country...but that voters still don't want to see her as the Republican Vice Presidential candidate next year. 56% of voters in the state approve of the job Haley is doing to only 28% who disapprove. Her numbers with Republicans (71/18) and independents (53/27) are good but what really sets her apart from other Governors across the country is that she's at almost break even (40/42) even with Democratic voters. That's a very unusual amount of cross over support these days. The good numbers with Democrats are particularly fueled by her being at 45/30 with African Americans, suggesting continued goodwill toward her for the leadership she provided in taking down the Confederate flag. Despite (or perhaps because of) Haley's popularity, only 25% of voters want to see her on the Republican ticket next year to 59% who don't want her to be.

Tim Scott (46/25 approval) is miles ahead of Lindsey Graham (30/51 approval) when it comes to who South Carolina's more popular Senator is. Scott looks like a pretty overwhelming favorite for reelection next year- he leads Joyce Dickerson 53/25 in a hypothetical match up.

Hillary Clinton trails all of the Republican candidates for President in South Carolina by anywhere from 2 to 12 points. By far the Republican who does best against Clinton is Ben Carson who leads 51/39. Jeb Bush leads her 47/41, Marco Rubio and Donald Trump both do 47/42, Mike Huckabee's up 47/43, Carly Fiorina is ahead 45/41, Ted Cruz has a 46/43 advantage, and the smallest lead is John Kasich's at 43/41.

Bernie Sanders does on average 7 points worse than Clinton in match ups with the comparable Republicans in South Carolina. He trails Carson 51/33, Bush 48/35, Rubio 46/33, Cruz 45/35, and Trump 48/38.

"Hillary Clinton does a little better against most of her potential Republican opponents in South Carolina than Barack Obama did in 2008 and 2012," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "But the political climate would have to shift a lot more in Democrats' favor to make it a swing state."

Public Policy Polling surveyed 1,290 South Carolina voters on November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th. The survey's margin of error is +/-2.7%. 80% of participants responded via the phone, while 20% of respondents who did not have landlines conducted the survey over the internet.
