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VA-5 Looks Competitive

Raleigh, N.C. – Virginia’s 5th Congressional District produced one of the most competitive House races in the country in 2008 and it looks like it’s ready to do so again in 2010.

Tom Perriello is tied with Republican frontrunner Robert Hurt at 44% each. Former Congressman Virgil Goode has hinted he may run as an independent if the GOP doesn’t nominate someone sufficiently conservative. In that instance Perriello and Goode tie at 41% with Hurt getting just 12%.

Perriello leads the rest of the GOP field in head to head contests. He has a 46-42 advantage over Ken Boyd, a 45-37 one over Jim McKelvey, a 45-36 edge over Michael McPadden, and a 44-34 one over Laurence Verga.

Voters are relatively divided on Perriello’s performance so far with 42% approving to 46% who are unhappy with him. None of the Republican candidates have better than 30% name recognition. Goode is by far the most popular potential contender, as 58% of voters view him favorably to only 29% who see him negatively. The Republican nomination would be his for the taking if he changed his mind about seeking it.

46% of voters in the district approve of the job Barack Obama’s doing to 50% who disapprove. Just 32% support the Democratic health care plan with 52% in opposition.

“Right now it’s clear this will be a closely contested race,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. “What Virgil Goode ends up deciding to do is a pretty significant factor though. If he decided to run as a Republican he’d probably be the favorite.”

PPP will release Republican primary numbers tomorrow.

PPP surveyed 924 registered voters in Virginia’s 5th Congressional District from February 5th to 10th. The margin of error for the survey is +/-3.2%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
