



Wake County Survey

Q1 In November of 2006, Wake County voters passed a 970 million dollar school construction bond. If you were asked to vote on another billion dollar school construction bond during this October's election, would you favor or oppose the bond? If favor, press 1 on your keypad now. If oppose, press 2. If you are undecided, press 3.

Favor26% *Undecided*..... 6%
Oppose68%

Q2 The Wake County Commissioners want a school bond referendum to be held this year in October of 2007, but the School Board would prefer the referendum be held later, in 2008 or 2009. Would you prefer to vote on this referendum this year or later? If you prefer this year, 2007, press 1. If a later year, press 2. If you don't know, or have no opinion, press 3.

This year 30% *Don't know* 10%
Later year..... 60%

Q3 Would you be more or less likely to vote for a school board member or county commissioner who supported a school bond in 2007? If more likely, press 1. If less likely, press 2. If neither, press 3.

More likely..... 22% *Neither* 19%
Less likely 58%

Q4 To relieve overcrowding in schools and to decrease construction costs, some argue for mandatory year-round schools. Others want to protect the traditional school calendar and want only voluntary year-round schools. Do you support or oppose mandatory year-round schools? If you support mandatory year-round schools, press 1. If opposed, press 2. If you don't know or have no opinion, press 3.

Support 49% *Don't know* 7%
Oppose 43%

Q5 Wake County Public Schools are currently allowed to teach abstinence only with no sex education. Do you favor or oppose allowing the public schools to provide voluntary sex education? If in favor allowing sex education, press 1. If opposed, press 2. If you don't know or don't have an opinion, press 3.

Favor.....69% *Don't know* 6%
Oppose 25%

Q6 If you are a woman, press 1, if a man, press 2.

Women55% *Men*.....45%

Q7 If you are a Democrat, press 1. A Republican, press 2. If other, press 3.

Democrat.....43% *Other*.....21%
Republican.....36%

Q8 If you are white, press one now. If you are African-American, press two now. If other, press 3.

White81% *Other*..... 7%
Black.....12%

Q9 If you are 18 to 29 years old, press 1 now. If you are 30 to 45, press 2. If you are 46 to 60, press 3. If older, press 4.

18-29..... 3% *46-60*.....35%
30-45.....31% *Older than 60*.....31%
