



## Wake County Survey: May 31, 2006

**Q1** Because the Dix hospital will soon move, the state legislature must decide how to use the 306 acre Dorthea Dix site. Some people see this as the last opportunity to have a large family and recreational park so close to downtown Raleigh. Others want a smaller park with the rest of the land used for office buildings and condominiums. If you want all the land used for a family and recreation park, press 1 now. If you want a smaller park plus condominiums and office buildings, press 2. If you don't have an opinion, press 3.

*All land for park.....65% No opinion.....11%*

**Q2** How important to you is it that all the available Dix land be used for a park? If very important, press 1. If somewhat important, press 2. If mildly important, press 3. If not important, press 4. (Only those who answered 1 for Question 1)

*Very important .....64% Mildly important..... 7%*

important.....29% Not important..... 1%*

**Q3** Organized Park supporters want state legislators from Wake County to introduce legislation to create a park district for building and managing the 300 acre park. The Dix Hospital buildings would be closed, but the state would continue to use its office buildings. If your state legislator worked for this bill, would you be more or less likely to vote for that legislator. If you would be more likely, press 1. If less likely, press 2. If it would make no difference to your vote, press 3.

*More likely.....62% Make no difference .19%*

*Less likely .....19%*

**Q4** If you are a woman, press 1, if a man, press 2.

*Women .....58% Men.....42%*

**Q5** If you are a Democrat, press 1. A Republican, press 2. If other, press 3.

*Democrat.....46% Other.....19%*

*Republican.....35%*

**Q6** If you are white, press one now. If you are African-American, press two now. If other, press 3.

*White .....73% Other..... 7%*

*Black.....20%*

**Q7** If you are 18 to 29 years old, press 1 now. If you are 30 to 45, press 2. If you are 46 to 60, press 3. If older, press 4.

*18-29..... 5% 46-60.....38%*

*30-45.....27% Older than 60.....30%*
